A painting exhibition by artist Vera de Jong.

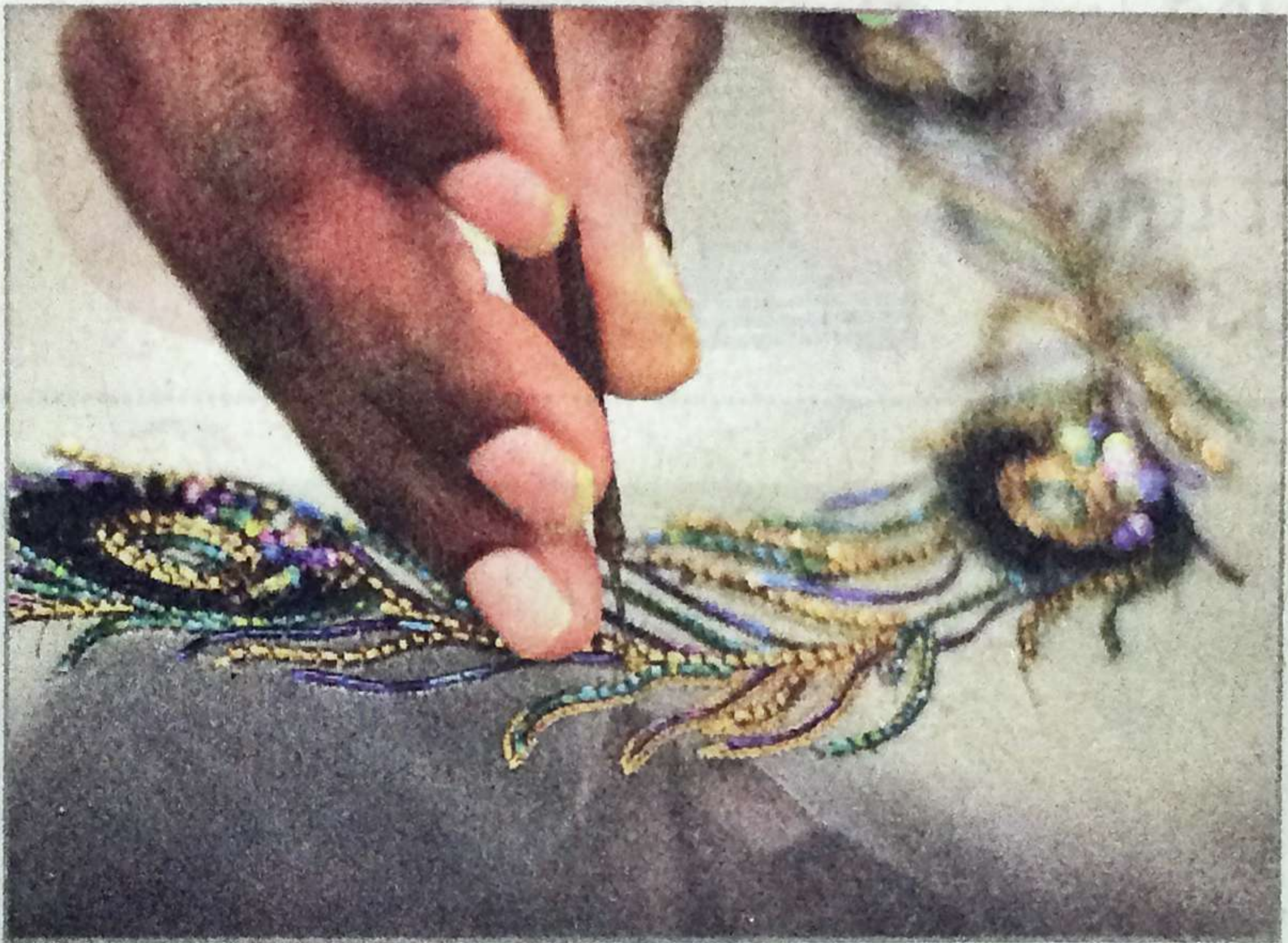

An exhibition that showcases traditional art of aari embroidery.

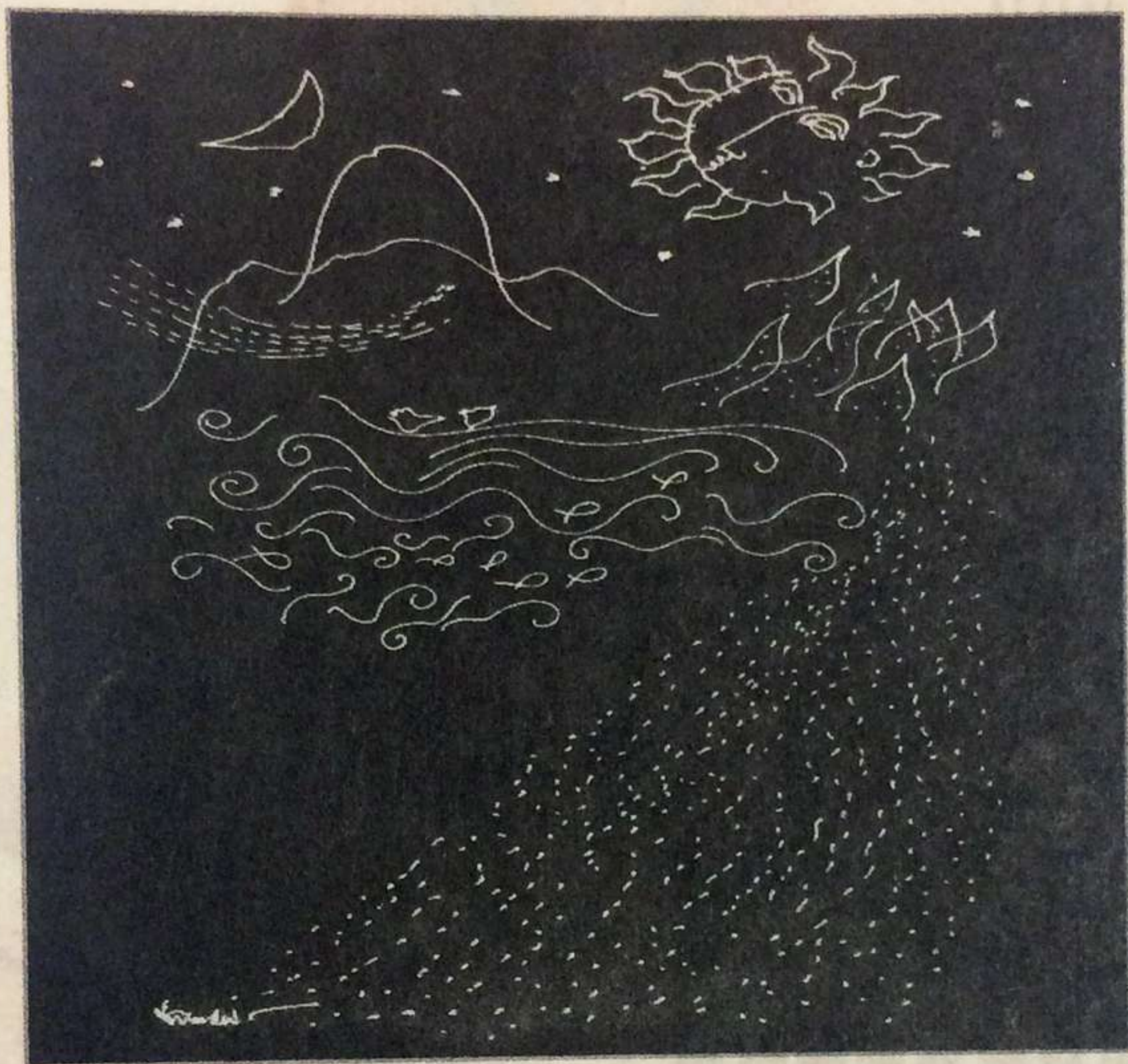

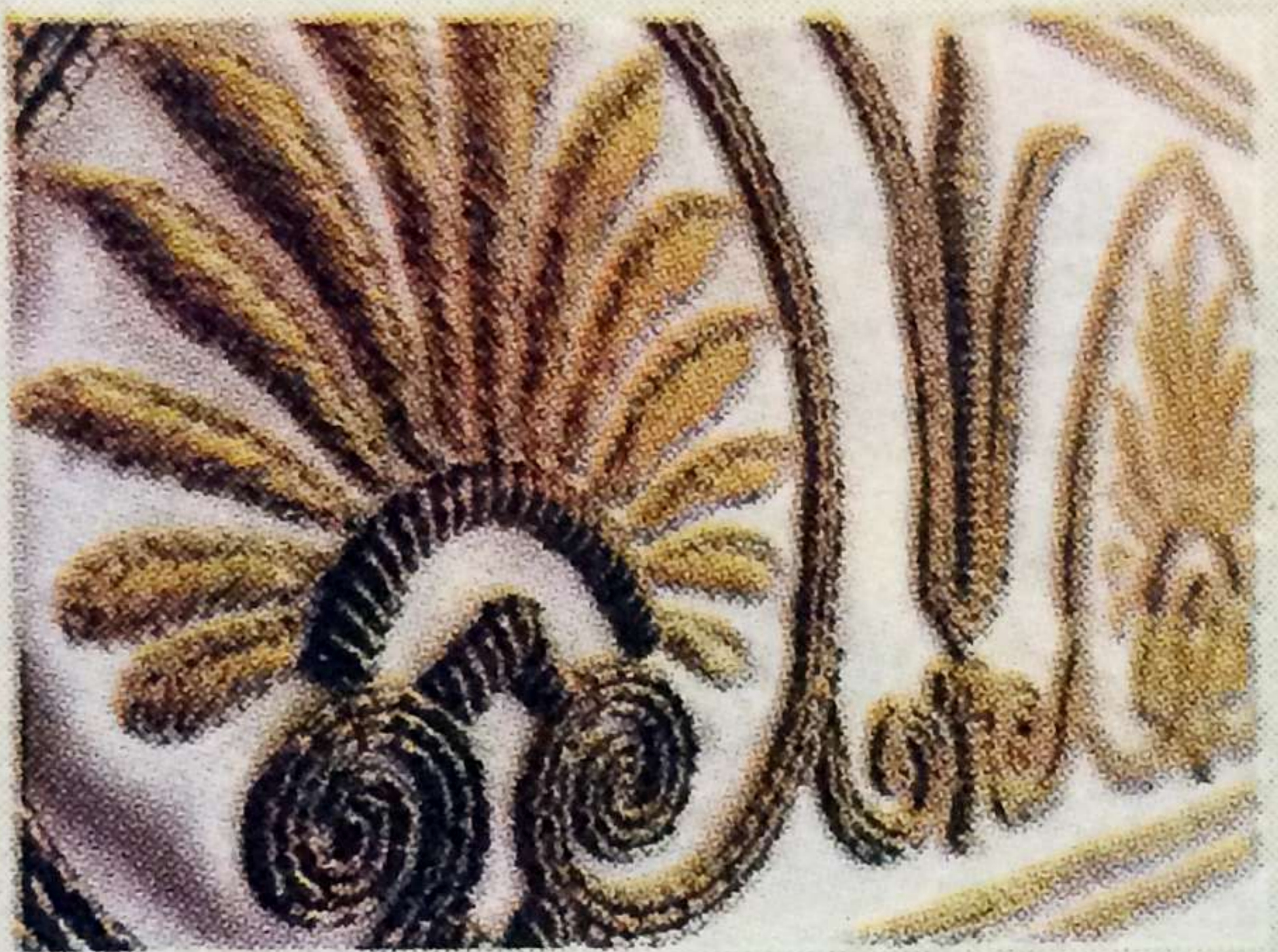
