





- India is Korea's 6th largest exporting, 22th largest importing country
- Korea is India's 18th largest exporting, 7th largest importing country
- Major Exports Petroleum Products, Auto Parts, Telephone Sets, Synthetic Resins
- · Major Imports Aluminum, Petroleum Products, Textile, Iron













